

# Gazania

## *Gazania spp.*



- Weed profile:** Perennial, Herb
- Habitat:** crops, native vegetation, gardens
- Impact:** Invades bushland, crops and vineyards.

### **Description:**

Perennial herb forming tussocks or with creeping stems. Leaves are simple and narrow, or deeply divided; dark green above and felted with white hairs below. Large daisy flowerheads in yellow, white, orange or pink.

### **Control options:**

Glyphosate (360g/L) Spray when actively growing. Attention to Conservation areas, bushland and other non-crop areas.

### **Legal requirements in Adelaide Region**

#### **Control**

Land owners in this region to take reasonable steps to kill plants and prevent their spread. Enforceable by the Green Adelaide Board.

#### **Sale**

Must not be sold or traded in any way, including as a contaminant of anything.

#### **Movement**

Must not be transported on a public road, including as a contaminant of anything.

#### **Entry**

Must not be imported into the Adelaide region.
